McGuffey High School Dual Enrollment Information

Program Description

- Dual Enrollment enables high school juniors and seniors to earn college credits while still enrolled as a student at McGuffey High School.
- Courses must be offered by an accredited two or four-year, public or private college or university, or a private license school that offers an associate degree. (University of Valley Forge)
- Courses are in core academic subjects and the humanities including English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Art, and Languages.
- The course must be non-remedial and have a strong history of transfer to other colleges and universities.
- Students may not enroll in more than two courses per college semester.
- Students will receive one high school credit for each successfully completed college course.
- Students are responsible to submit an official college transcript to receive McGuffey High School credit.

Eligible Students

- Currently enrolled McGuffey High School juniors and seniors.
- Evidence that the student is making satisfactory progress toward graduation.
- A score of "Advanced" or "Proficient" on all three Keystone Algebra I, Keystone Literature, and Keystone Biology Assessments.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 or higher.
- A demonstrated readiness for college-level course work in the intended subject area of study.
- Satisfactory school attendance as determined by the school district.
